Vaccine reminder for all adults from 5 months after their last injection, health pass conditioned to the booster dose from 15 January 2022, duration of the tests reduced to 24 hours for the sanitary pass of the unvaccinated, wearing of the mask mandatory everywhere inside...
Face 5^e In the wake of the Covid-19 epidemic, new measures were announced by the Minister of Health and the Minister of National Education at a press conference on November 25, 2021.

Facing the outbreak of the Covid-19 epidemic of the 5^e On Thursday, November 25, 2021, the Minister of Health announced new measures to curb the spread of the virus, including:

- the vaccination recall is open to all adults as early as 5 months after their last injection starting on Saturday, November 27. People over 65 years of age, for whom the vaccine recall had already been opened since September, will now be able to receive their booster dose 5 months after the last injection, not 6;
- All persons over 18 years of age must have received a booster dose no more than 7 months after their last injection to receive a valid health pass as of January 15, 2022. For example, someone who has received a 2^e dose on 1^{er} July can have 3^e from 1^{er} December, and will have to do it before the 1^{er} February 2022 to preserve its sanitary pass;
- the validity period of the Covid-19 negative tests which qualify for the health pass is reduced to 24 hours instead of 72 hours;
- wearing the mandatory mask throughout the interior, including in places where the sanitary pass is required.

In addition, the Minister of National Education has announced that primary school classes will no longer close on the 1st Covid-19. A systematic screening of the whole class will take place and only students with a negative test will be able to return to the class.
